



Participation Policy for the Event or the Seminar

Definitions

“Admission Product” means any right of entry, access, participation, or attendance issued or made available by the Organiser in connection with the Event or any Event Feature, whether free of charge or paid, including (without limitation) registrations, admissions, badges, passes, credentials, tickets, or any paid or complimentary access.

Attendance and Participation

Only pre-registered visitors who are badge holders, visitors who register onsite, and exhibitors who are badge holders will be able to attend the Event and any associated seminars, conferences, features, or activities (collectively, the “Event”) held by RX BITEC (“Organiser”).

Admission is open only to professional and business visitors and exhibitors who are involved in, or have a direct connection or interest in, the subject area of the Event or the associated industries or organisations.

Age Eligibility

Only individuals aged 15 years or older are eligible to register for and attend the Event.

Individuals under the age of 20 years may attend only if:

- (a) they are accompanied at all times by their legal guardian, who is aged 20 years or older; and
- (b) the Organiser has received any guardian consent or acknowledgement required by the Organiser at the time of registration, badge issuance, badge activation, or admission.

Individuals under the age of 15 years are not permitted to attend the Event under any circumstances.

Where an attendee is under the age of 20 years, any consent, acknowledgement or acceptance required in connection with that attendee’s registration, attendance, image use, or personal data processing shall be given or confirmed by the attendee’s legal guardian in the manner specified by the Organiser.

Registration and Onsite Registration Fees

Attendees may be required to register in advance or onsite, subject to the Organiser’s requirements for the relevant Event.

Where the Organiser elects to charge an onsite registration fee for a particular Event, attendees who register onsite may be required to pay a supplemental onsite registration fee. Any applicable onsite registration fee, including the amount and currency, will be clearly disclosed on the relevant Event registration platform or at the venue.

The Organiser reserves the right to determine, vary, or waive any registration or onsite registration fees on an Event-by-Event basis.

Data Sharing

By choosing to allow their badge or other Admission Product to be scanned by an exhibitor or sponsor at the Event, a Participant affirmatively instructs the Organiser to disclose to that exhibitor or sponsor the registration details associated with that badge or Admission Product, which may include the Participant's name, contact details, and other registration information provided by the Participant.

The Participant acknowledges that, following such disclosure, the relevant exhibitor or sponsor may use the disclosed personal data for its own purposes, including contacting the Participant regarding its products or services, in accordance with that exhibitor's or sponsor's own privacy policy.

The Organiser is not responsible for the privacy practices of exhibitors or sponsors in respect of personal data disclosed following a Participant's decision to permit badge scanning. Participants should review the applicable exhibitor or sponsor privacy policy before allowing their badge or Admission Product to be scanned.

Where the Participant is under the age of 20 years, any consent or instruction required under this section must be given or confirmed by the Participant's legal guardian in the manner required by the Organiser.

Badge Security

- Participants must not allow their Admission Product (including badges or credentials) to be worn or used by any other person. Loaning or transferring to others is strictly prohibited.
- Any failure to comply with this provision, or any provision in this policy, is likely to lead to the Participant and the person wearing the badge being removed from the Event.
- Anyone obtaining a badge by theft, deception or other illegal means will likely be asked to leave the Event.

Identity Check

Anyone attending the Event should carry and produce on request of the Organiser a personal photo-ID (e.g., passport, photo-ID driving license, national identity card) or other identification acceptable to the Organiser.

Service Animals

With the exception of guide dogs or other service animals, no pets or animals of any description will be allowed into the Event.

Activity

Anyone attending the Event must not take part in any canvassing, leafleting, demonstrations, objectionable behaviour or wear offensive apparel or be involved in any activity which may disrupt the Event.

Press

- Press badges at the Event are restricted to publishers, editors, journalists, photographers, broadcasters and web bloggers associated with the industry.
- All members of the press must wear the badges distributed in the press room.

Photography and Recording

- Photographers and film crew may be taking photographs and recording and/or streaming videos at the Event. Each attendee authorises such photography and recording and permits the Organiser, its parents, affiliates, sublicensees, designees, agents and assignees (including, without limitation, any sponsors, exhibitors or contractors to the Event) to use the attendee's image, likeness, appearance, and/or voice and to publish, reproduce, portray, distribute and/or otherwise use the image, likeness, appearance, and/or voice in all media formats (whether now known or hereafter existing), worldwide, solely in connection with the distribution, promotion and publicity of both the Event (including future editions thereof) and Organiser's general business, services or products, without liability, compensation or credit to the attendee. If the attendee is under the age of 20, such attendee's legal guardian consents on their behalf. Where the attendee is under the age of 20 years, any consent required under this section must be given or confirmed by the attendee's legal guardian in the manner required by the Organiser.
- No exhibitor, visitor, or other attendee may take photographs or make any audio or video recording at the Event without the prior written permission of: (a) the person being photographed or recorded, where identifiable; (b) the relevant exhibitor, stand owner, or rights holder where applicable; and/or (c) the Organiser, where required by the Organiser's rules.

Event Features

- the Event may include panels, education sessions, networking events, seminars, workshops, special activities, virtual components, or other features (collectively, the “Event Features”).
- Access to certain Event Features may:
 - be subject to availability;
 - require advance registration;
 - be limited to designated categories of Participants; and/or
 - require payment of an additional Admission Product fee or other fee, as determined by the Organiser and disclosed through the relevant Event registration channel..
- The Organiser does not guarantee access to any particular Event Feature.
- Participants are solely responsible for attending Event Features at the specified times. Failure to attend on time or at all does not entitle the Participant to any refund, substitution, or alternative access.

Cancellation or Postponement of the Event

The Organiser reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to cancel, postpone, reschedule, or modify the Event or any part of it at any time.

In the event of cancellation, postponement, rescheduling, or material modification of the Event:

- (a) the Organiser shall not be responsible for any travel costs, accommodation costs, loss of opportunity, loss of profit, incidental expenses, indirect losses, or consequential damages incurred by any Participant; and
- (b) any refund, credit, transfer, or replacement in respect of a paid Admission Product shall be governed by the refund or registration terms communicated for the relevant Event through the applicable registration channel or, if no such terms are specified, as determined by the Organiser in its discretion, subject to applicable law.

For the avoidance of doubt, unless expressly stated otherwise by the Organiser in writing for a particular Event, the Organiser shall have no obligation to reimburse any costs or expenses other than, where applicable, the price paid for the relevant paid Admission Product in accordance with this section.



Non-Refundable and Non-Transferable Policy

Except as required by applicable law or expressly stated by the Organiser in writing for a specific Event:

- (a) all Admission Products are non-refundable and non-transferable;
- (b) Admission Products may not be resold, exchanged, transferred, assigned, shared, or reproduced; and
- (c) no refund, credit, substitution, replacement, or alternative access will be issued in the event of failure to attend, partial attendance, late arrival, refusal of entry due to non-compliance with this policy, or removal due to breach of this policy.

Reservation of Rights

The Organiser reserves the right to exclude or remove anyone from the Event and the venue who does not comply with this policy or who they reasonably consider is likely to break these rules or who is prohibited from attending under any applicable sanctions, laws or regulations, or otherwise at the Organiser's discretion.

Privacy

By participating in the Event or by submitting information to Organiser in connection with the Event, Participant agrees to the terms of Organiser's Privacy Policy, located at <https://privacy.rxglobal.com/> and which may be updated by Organiser at any time. A Participant's continued participation in the Event shall constitute a Participant's acceptance of any such updated Privacy Policy. All Participants are expected to review the Privacy Policy carefully before participating in the Event and Participant acknowledges that, in the event of a conflict or inconsistency between these Terms of Service and the Privacy Policy, the terms of the Privacy Policy shall prevail, govern and control.

Event Policies

At all times in connection with the Event, Participant is required to comply with and behave in accordance with (i) this Participation Policy; (ii) all applicable laws, ordinances, codes, regulations, standards and judicial or administrative orders; and (iii) any additional Event rules, regulations, codes of conduct, policies, terms of use or procedures which may be posted at the Venue or otherwise distributed to Participants by Organiser and as may be updated from time to time by Organiser (collectively, the "Event Policies"). By Participating in the Event, Participant acknowledges and agrees that Participant has read, agrees to comply with, and will behave in accordance with the Event Policies.

The Event Policies apply to EVERYONE participating in the Event in any manner whatsoever, including, but not limited to, all Participants, exhibitors, attendees, speakers, guests, professionals, media, staff members, workers, contractors, vendors, volunteers, security or anyone else participating in any way. Each Participant is solely responsible for their own conduct while Participating in the Event or any part of the Event.

As part of the Event Policies, each Participant agrees that they will not, and will not directly or indirectly cause others to, do any of the following “Prohibited Activities” in connection with the Event:

- (i) interfere with, damage, or engage in any act which disrupts the operation of the Event in any way, including but not limited to, obstructing aisles or entrances or exits, running, cutting in line, saving places in lines for others, jumping over barriers or guardrails, using foul language, screaming, yelling, encouraging disruptive behavior from others, disobeying any time limits, directions or prohibitions provided to Participant by Organiser’s staff and/or moderators, or preventing any other participant from Participating in the Event by any means;
- (ii) distribute, wear, transmit, upload, display or otherwise circulate any content which is inaccurate, unlawful, infringing, defamatory, obscene, pornographic, invasive of privacy or publicity rights, harassing, threatening, abusive, inflammatory, or otherwise objectionable to Organiser in Organiser’s sole discretion;
- (iii) distribute printed or recorded materials of any kind unless prior written approval has been obtained from Organiser;
- (iv) impersonate any other person or entity or perform any similar fraudulent activities;
- (v) sell goods or services, display goods or services, make solicitations of any kind, or conduct any commercial activities without the prior written approval of Organiser;
- (vi) harvest, collect, or attempt to collect the personal information, email addresses or other contact information of other participants in the Event without the consent of such participants without the prior written consent of Organiser;
- (vii) defame, harass, abuse, threaten or defraud other participants in the Event.
- (viii) circumvent, disable, damage, remove or otherwise interfere with the security, integrity, or proper conduct of the Event;
- (ix) access any unauthorized part of the Event designated as only for Organiser use;
- (x) access the Platform by means of any robot, spider, scraper, crawler or other automated means for any purpose;
- (xi) Participate in the Event for any illegal purpose, or in violation of any applicable local, state, national, or international law or regulation, including, without limitation, laws governing intellectual property and other proprietary rights, data protection and privacy;

- (xii) smoke within the Venue for a live Event, which includes, but is not limited to, cigarettes, vape pens, and marijuana;
- (xiii) drink or possess alcohol within the Venue outside of the specifically designated areas. No one under the age of 20 may consume alcohol within or around the Venue;
- (xiv) use, sell, possess, or distribute any illegal drugs or other illegal substances, including, but not limited to, any medication that has not been legally obtained, is not being used in its intended dosage or for its intended purpose;
- (xv) assault, steal, fight, engage in or incite violence of any kind, including, but not limited to, verbal threats of violence; and
- (xvi) possess and/or use any of the following prohibited items in connection with the Event:
 - a firearm, ammunition, knife, or weapon of any kind;
 - objects or toys that appear to be firearms, ammunition, knives, or weapons;
 - self-defense or restraining devices;
 - fireworks or other explosive or flammable objects;
 - glass containers;
 - recreational devices such as drones, remote control toys, skateboards, scooters, inline skates or shoes with built-in wheels;
 - strollers;
 - folding chairs;
 - balloons.

NOTE: Organiser has a ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY for weapons of any kind. Event security and local law enforcement officials will treat anything that looks like a real gun as a real gun.

Safety and Security

Personal belongings must be carried at all times and not left unattended.

Please be advised that a risk of exposure to communicable disease, including COVID-19, exists in any event or public space, including the Event. Prior to registering for and attending the Event, each Participant must ensure they have read the latest public health guidance for the location of the Event. ***By attending the Event, Participant acknowledges this inherent risk on behalf of Participant (“You”) and, as a condition of entering the Event, You acknowledge, understand and confirm*** that You will abide by all terms of admission and participation (as may be updated from time to time) and Event health-and-safety requirements, all local public health regulations and guidance from the relevant city and/or state which are in effect at the time of entry, and, where applicable, provide proof of compliance with any Event entry requirements.

Participant's interactions with third parties, including, but not limited to, guests and other participants in connection with the Event, are solely between Participant and such third party. Participant acknowledges and agrees that Organiser will not be responsible for any damages, losses, costs, expenses, or liabilities incurred as the result of such interactions with third parties.

After the event, please dispose of your admission badge on the event site or upon your return home, and do not dispose of it in the trash cans outside the Event site.

Assumption of Risk and Release

Participant acknowledges that participation in the Event may involve certain inherent risks, including risks associated with crowds, equipment, activities, travel, and exposure to communicable illness. By participating in the Event, Participant voluntarily assumes such inherent risks to the extent permitted by applicable law. Participant also agrees to comply with all health, safety, security, and admission requirements communicated by the Organiser, the venue, or applicable governmental authorities.

To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, Participant releases and discharges the Organiser, the Event venue, and each of their respective parent, affiliated, and subsidiary companies, and each of their respective officers, directors, employees, agents, contractors, sponsors, and representatives (collectively, the "Released Parties") from claims arising out of Participant's participation in the Event, except to the extent arising from the fraud, wilful misconduct, gross negligence, or other liability of any Released Party that cannot lawfully be excluded or limited.

Nothing in this policy excludes or limits any liability that cannot be excluded or limited under applicable law.

This section shall be binding only to the extent permitted by applicable law and, where the Participant is under the age of 20 years, shall be subject to any consent or acknowledgement required from the Participant's legal guardian in the manner specified by the Organiser.
